DAY 1 and 2 Leviticus 16 Day of Atonement

What did Aaron do on the Day of Atonement?

Note what is said about the blood. (chart-pg 54)

1. (3-6, 11-14) make atonement for himself/household bull-sin offering; bring incense, **blood** inside the veil
2. (7-10, 15) make atonement for the people two goats, cast lots, goat-sin offering, **blood** inside the veil (16-17) make atonement for the holy place (tent of meeting)
3. (18-19) make atonement for the altar **blood** on horns of the altar on all sides; sprinkle **it** 7 times
4. (20-22) offer live goat, lay hands on head, confess over it, sent it into wilderness
5. (23-25, 27-28) change out of linen garment, bathe, dress; offer burnt offerings, fat of sin offering; make atonement; bull/goat (sin offerings) burn outside camp
6. (26) One who released scapegoat; wash clothes, bathe, then come into camp

When: (29) seventh month on the tenth day

How long: (29, 31, 34) permanent statue

Who for: (29) native, alien sojourning

How celebrate: (29, 31) humble your souls / not work; Sabbath of solemn rest for you

Why: (30) to cleanse you; you will be clean from all your sins before the Lord

How often: (34) once every year

DAY 3 Leviticus 17 Life is in the blood

What instruction is given about blood? Why?

17:3-7

slaughters...v4 not present it as an offering... bloodguiltiness...has shed **blood**...shall be cut off sacrifice as sacrifices of peace offering to the Lord.

Priest sprinkle the **blood** on the altar of the Lord; no longer sacrifice to the goat demons with which they play the harlot.

17:10-12

Anyone who eats any **blood**, I will set My face against; cut him off

17:11 the life of the flesh is in the **blood**, and I have given it to you on the altar to make atonement for your souls; for it is the **blood** by reason of the life that makes atonement.

'No person may eat **blood**, nor any alien who sojourns among you eat **blood**'.

17:13 catch a beast or bird which may be eaten, pour out its **blood** and cover **it** with earth

17:14 the life of all flesh, its **blood** is identified with its life... not to eat the **blood** of any flesh, for the life of all flesh is its **blood**; whoever eats it shall be cut off.'

DAY 4 and 5

Hebrews 8-10:22

What did Jesus do as our high priest?

1. (9:11-12, 24) Where did He enter?
Greater, perfect tabernacle, true holy place, heaven
2. (9:11-12) How did He enter?
Through His own **blood**
3. (9:14) What did He offer?
Offered Himself without blemish to God
4. (9:12, 25-26, 28 10:10) How often?
Once for all (**25** contrast with high priest that enters holy place year by year with **blood** not his own)
5. (9:12, 14; 10:10, 14-22) What result for us?
9:12 Eternal redemption; 9:14 clean conscience (**9:13** contrast with **blood** of goats/ bull/ ashes of heifer)
10:10 sanctified; 10:14 perfected; 10:16 laws on heart, in mind;
10:17 forgiveness of sins, (**10:4** contrast with **blood** of bull/goat);
10:19 confidence to enter holy place by the **blood** of Jesus
