

Acts 7:38, 51-53

- 38 “This is the one who was in the congregation in the wilderness together with the angel who was speaking to him on Mount Sinai, and *who was* with our fathers; and he received living oracles to pass on to you.
- 51 “You men who are stiff-necked and uncircumcised in heart and ears are always resisting the Holy Spirit; you are doing just as your fathers did.
- 52 “Which one of the prophets did your fathers not persecute? They killed those who had previously announced the coming of the Righteous One, whose betrayers and murderers you have now become;
- 53 you who received the law as ordained by angels, and *yet* did not keep it.”

Galatians 3:19

Why the Law then? It was added because of transgressions, having been ordained through angels by the agency of a mediator, until the seed would come to whom the promise had been made.

Deuteronomy 33:1-2

- 1 Now this is the blessing with which Moses the man of God blessed the sons of Israel before his death.
- 2 He said,
“The LORD came from Sinai,
And dawned on them from Seir;
He shone forth from Mount Paran,
And He came from the midst of ten thousand holy ones;
At His right hand there was flashing lightning for them.

Leviticus 20:7-16

- 7 ‘You shall consecrate yourselves therefore and be holy, for I am the LORD your God.
- 8 ‘You shall keep My statutes and practice them; I am the LORD who sanctifies you.
- 9 ‘If *there is* anyone who curses his father or his mother, he shall surely be put to death; he has cursed his father or his mother, his bloodguiltiness is upon him.
- 10 ‘If *there is* a man who commits adultery with another man’s wife, one who commits adultery with his friend’s wife, the adulterer and the adulteress shall surely be put to death.
- 11 ‘If *there is* a man who lies with his father’s wife, he has uncovered his father’s nakedness; both of them shall surely be put to death, their bloodguiltiness is upon them.
- 12 ‘If *there is* a man who lies with his daughter-in-law, both of them shall surely be put to death; they have committed incest, their bloodguiltiness is upon them.
- 13 ‘If *there is* a man who lies with a male as those who lie with a woman, both of them have committed a detestable act; they shall surely be put to death. Their bloodguiltiness is upon them.
- 14 ‘If *there is* a man who marries a woman and her mother, it is immorality; both he and they shall be burned with fire, so that there will be no immorality in your midst.
- 15 ‘If *there is* a man who lies with an animal, he shall surely be put to death; you shall also kill the animal.
- 16 ‘If *there is* a woman who approaches any animal to mate with it, you shall kill the woman and the animal; they shall surely be put to death. Their bloodguiltiness is upon them.

Leviticus 24:13-17

- 13 Then the LORD spoke to Moses, saying,
14 “Bring the one who has cursed outside the camp, and let all who heard him lay their hands on his head; then let all the congregation stone him.
15 “You shall speak to the sons of Israel, saying, ‘If anyone curses his God, then he will bear his sin.
16 ‘Moreover, the one who blasphemes the name of the LORD shall surely be put to death; all the congregation shall certainly stone him. The alien as well as the native, when he blasphemes the Name, shall be put to death.
17 ‘If a man takes the life of any human being, he shall surely be put to death.

Leviticus 26:13-18

- 13 ‘I am the LORD your God, who brought you out of the land of Egypt so that *you* would not be their slaves, and I broke the bars of your yoke and made you walk erect.
14 ‘But if you do not obey Me and do not carry out all these commandments,
15 if, instead, you reject My statutes, and if your soul abhors My ordinances so as not to carry out all My commandments, *and* so break My covenant,
16 I, in turn, will do this to you: I will appoint over you a sudden terror, consumption and fever that will waste away the eyes and cause the soul to pine away; also, you will sow your seed uselessly, for your enemies will eat it up.

Hebrews 10

- 28 Anyone who has set aside the Law of Moses dies without mercy *on the testimony of* two or three witnesses.
29 How much severer punishment do you think he will deserve who has trampled under foot the Son of God, and has regarded as unclean the blood of the covenant by which he was sanctified, and has insulted the Spirit of grace?

Pay attention - [*prosecho*] 1 to bring to, bring near. 1A to bring a ship to land, and simply to touch at, put in. 2 to turn the mind to, attend to be attentive. 2A to a person or a thing: of caring for, providing for. 3 to attend to one’s self, i.e. to give heed to one’s self. 3A give attention to, take heed. 4 to apply one’s self to, attach one’s self to, hold or cleave to a person or a thing. 4A to be given or addicted to. 4B to devote thought and effort to.¹

Drift away - [*pararrhuego*] 1 to glide by, pass by. 1A lest the salvation which these things heard show us how to obtain, slip away from us. 1B a thing escapes me. 1C slips my mind.¹

Neglect - [*ameleo*] 1 to be careless of, to neglect.¹

Romans 15:18-19

- 18 For I will not presume to speak of anything except what Christ has accomplished through me, resulting in the obedience of the Gentiles by word and deed,
19 in the power of signs and wonders, in the power of the Spirit; so that from Jerusalem and round about as far as Illyricum I have fully preached the gospel of Christ.

2 Corinthians 12:11-12

- 11 I have become foolish; you yourselves compelled me. Actually I should have been commended by you, for in no respect was I inferior to the most eminent apostles, even though I am a nobody.
12 The signs of a true apostle were performed among you with all perseverance, by signs and wonders and miracles.
